GUIDELINES FOR POSTER

Content

- The main objective of the posters is to provide a basis for discussing your work (accomplished and future goals).
- It's not necessary to provide a full account of what you did, or what you are planning.
- Present the general conceptual idea, and highlight points you want input on.
- Please provide a title of the poster at least one week in advance of the conference start to gk-emotions@uni-wuerzburg.de

Form

- Please use DIN A 0 format portrait (approx. height = 119cm; approx. width 84cm) for the poster.
- It could be useful to put a picture of you, and probably of your PI on the poster, to enhance identification of the author, allowing guests to approach you without knowing you.
